

Skate SA State Team Clothing Policy

(To be read in conjunction with Skate Australia's Bylaw 10)

The purpose of this By-Law is to provide a policy for the purchase and wearing of Skate SA State Team Clothing and Uniforms by all State team members, team managers and coaches selected to represent South Australia at various national events.

This Policy confirms that the Skate SA Board has the responsibility of approving Clothing and Uniforms, for all State teams.

This Policy deals with the appointment of official suppliers of all items of clothing and in particular those items that carry the Skate SA Logo and/ or the State Emblem (Piping Shrike).

The Skate SA Board may delegate the sourcing of suitable clothing suppliers to a State Branch however final approval in regards to design, colour and supplier must be given by the Skate SA Board.

1. Official Suppliers

The official supplier of all Skate SA Clothing and Uniforms (including all disciplines) will be appointed by the Skate SA Board.

All clothing provided by sponsors that bears reference to either the team or the event must be approved by the Skate SA Board.

2. Uniform Requirements - National Competitions

All State team members, managers and coaches ratified by the Skate SA Board will be required to purchase Skate SA State Uniforms specified from time to time by the Skate SA Board.

Compulsory Skate SA State uniforms bearing either State Emblem or Skate SA logos are only available to members selected to the relevant state team.

The State Emblem (Piping Shrike) must only be worn on the competitive uniform/playing jersey.

Any other official position but not part of the actual official team may wear their Branch or Skate SA uniform.

All Skate SA clothing and uniforms must be ordered through the correct channels from Skate SA's official supplier except for a few exceptions endorsed by the SkateSA Board. (ie Artistic Leotard)

3. Personal Coaches

Athlete's personal coaches may purchase and wear Skate SA State Clothing, only if they are accompanying athletes to the relevant competition.

Athlete's personal coaches may not wear the State Emblem (Piping Shrike) on any items of clothing.

4. Supporters

Accompanying supporters do not have permission to purchase or wear any items of Skate SA Official State Uniform. They may purchase Official Supporters wear.

Athletes may be permitted to include sponsors logos on Official State Team uniforms subject to Skate SA and Skate Australia policies at the time and approval of the Skate SA Board.
